TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF BUNTING STREET

RE: 2023 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM

BUNTING STREET FROM CHURCH AVENUE TO INKSTER BOULEVARD

Please be advised that construction on Bunting Street will soon begin.

Construction Start Date: Week of May 15th, 2023

Duration: Approximately 11 weeks, weather permitting

As part of this work we will:

- Mill existing asphalt
- Repair the concrete pavement
- Install catch pits and adjust manholes and catch basins
- Repair the sewer
- Replace missing and damaged curbs
- Construct a new sidewalk on the west side of Bunting Street
- Restore the boulevard
- Place an asphalt overlay

During construction:

- Traffic will be limited to one-way southbound during northbound construction and one-way northbound during southbound construction
- On-street parking will be removed
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual
 - Crews will move and return them as required

We recognize that this project will cause some inconvenience and disruption and we thank you for your understanding and patience during construction.

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs, moving requirements, underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within six meters (20 feet) of the street curb line
