Please be advised that construction on Gaynor Place will soon begin.

Construction Start Date: Week of May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023

Duration: Approximately 3 weeks, weather permitting

# As part of this work we will:

- Mill and repair existing asphalt
- Adjust manholes and catch basin
- Renew the curb
- Restore the boulevard
- Place an asphalt overlay

# **During construction:**

- One lane of two-way traffic will be maintained
  - o Periodic short-term full closures will be required
- On-street parking will be removed
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
  - Please place your bins as usual
  - Crews will move and return them as required

We recognize that this project will cause some inconvenience and disruption and we thank you for your understanding and patience during construction.
