RE: 2023 Streets Maintenance Preservation Project: Westbound Stradbrook Avenue – Queen Elizabeth Way to Harkness Avenue

Please be advised the existing surface of westbound Stradbrook Avenue from Queen Elizabeth Way to Harkness Avenue will soon be under construction.

Construction start:	June 2023
Duration:	8 weeks

We will:

- Repair the pavement to address deterioration in the roadway
- Diamond grind the surface for a smoother ride

Traffic impacts during construction:

- Westbound Stradbrook Avenue will be reduced to one lane
 - We will be working in stages to minimize disruptions and the directly impacted area
- Access to side streets and private properties will be maintained
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Garbage and recycling pick-up will not be affected
