RE: 2023 Industrial Street Renewal Project – Argyle Street between George Avenue and Disraeli Freeway

Please be advised Argyle Street between George Avenue and Disraeli Freeway is scheduled for renewal in Summer 2023.

Construction starts: Summer 2023
Duration: 6 weeks

We will:

- Repair the roadway pavement
- Repair curbs where required
- Repair and adjust underground infrastructure
- Place an asphalt pavement overlay
- Restore driveways and boulevards where required
- Relocate the sidewalk within the east boulevard of Argyle Street between 500 Waterfront Drive and Heaton Avenue
 - This sidewalk will be relocated to be closer to the road and align with the sidewalk within the east boulevard to the north and south.
