Please be advised that the above pathway renewal project has been approved for construction this summer as part of the City of Winnipeg's 2023 Pathway Renewals Program.

Preliminary information for this project is as follows:

**Construction Start: May to September 2023**  
**Duration: Approximately 6-8 weeks, weather permitting**

The work on Niakwa Trail will include:

- Excavation and milling of existing pathway
- Laying a new sub-base and base structure
- Asphalt paving the new path
- Boulevard regrading and restoration as required

**Traffic and Access Management**

Access to residents and businesses will be maintained.
