TO: Residents & Businesses

RE: 2023 Streets Maintenance Preservation Project:

Roblin Boulevard - Grant Avenue to 40m west of William Clement Parkway

Please be advised Roblin Boulevard between Grant Avenue and 40 m west of William Clement Parkway will be under construction in Summer 2023.

Construction start: Summer 2023 Duration: 10 weeks

We will:

- Repair existing pavement to address deterioration in the roadway
- Mill down and resurface the pavement with new asphalt
- Repair the curb
- · Replace portions of sidewalk as required
- Sod any disturbed grass areas

Traffic impacts during construction:

- Traffic will at times be reduced to one lane
 - We will be working in stages to minimize disruptions
- Parking on Roblin Boulevard will be removed
- Access to side streets and private properties will be maintained
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Garbage and recycling pick-up will not be affected

- Moving requirements
- Planned special events
- Any underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within six metres (20 feet) of the street curb line
