## CITY OF WINNIPEG PRE-CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

**TO: Residents/Businesses of River Avenue, Stradbrook Avenue, and Wellington Crescent**

**RE: River Avenue / Stradbrook Avenue / Wellington Crescent Pavement Renewals and Protected Bike Lanes**

In March 2023, we presented to the public, residents, and stakeholders the final design for protected bike lanes and pavement renewal on River Avenue, Stradbrook Avenue and Wellington Crescent. This project will also include pedestrian crossing upgrades, transit stop improvements, new trees and other elements that will together make cycling and walking through the area a safer, more convenient, and more attractive option.

Construction on this work is scheduled to start in June 2023. It will take place on River and Stradbrook between Wellington Crescent and Harkness Avenue as well as Wellington between River and Stradbrook. Please see the enclosed construction staging map included in this notice.

**Construction starts:** June 2023

**Duration:** 25 weeks

During construction we will:

- Repair the roadway pavement and replace curbs
- Repair and adjust underground infrastructure
- Place an asphalt pavement overlay where required
- Repair sidewalks and restore boulevards where required
- Install new protected bike lanes
- Construct Transit stop and pedestrian crossing improvements
- Upgrade Traffic signals

Traffic impacts during construction:

- On-street parking will be temporarily removed
- One lane of traffic will be maintained
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times

We will issue a second notice approximately one week prior to construction. 
