Please be advised that the above pathway renewal project has been approved for construction this summer as part of the City of Winnipeg's 2023 Pathway Renewals Program.

Preliminary information for this project is as follows:

**Construction Start: May to September 2023**  
**Duration: Approximately 6-8 weeks, weather permitting**

The work on Wellington Avenue will include:

- Excavation of boulevard and existing sidewalks
- Laying a new sub-base and base structure
- Concrete curb renewal
- Asphalt paving the new path
- Boulevard restoration as required

**Traffic and Access Management**

Lane closures will take place throughout the construction. Access to businesses will be maintained.
