2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF IRENE STREET

**RE: 2024 LOCAL INDUSTRIAL STREET RENEWALS
IRENE STREET – FROM CLARENCE AVENUE TO SONY PLACE**

Road construction on Irene Street from Clarence Avenue to Sony Place will soon begin.

Construction start window: Week of May 27, 2024
Duration: 18 Weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Build a new sidewalk on the west side of the street
- Repair and reconstruct the road (different sections will receive different treatments)
- Repair or rebuild approaches
- Repair drainage
- Restore the boulevards

As part of our sidewalk work we will improve existing Transit stops.

During construction:

- Southbound traffic will be limited to one lane
- We will temporarily close the intersection
 - We will provide advance notice of the closure
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties

Please contact if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
