TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF WEATHERDON AVENUE

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
WEATHERDON AVENUE FROM STAFFORD STREET TO ARBUTHNOT STREET**

Please be advised that road construction on Weatherdon Avenue will soon begin.

Construction Start Date: Week of May 27, 2024
Duration: Approximately 10-12 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Replace sidewalks
- Excavate and repave the existing roadway
- Repair sewer infrastructure and install new catch basins
- Replace curbs and concrete approaches

During construction:

- Weatherdon Avenue will be fully closed to traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks will be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual and Contractor will relocate bins for collection if needed, please mark your address on your bins so they can be returned to the correct address

Please contact me if you have:

- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions or concerns about the project

New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
