**RE: 2024 TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS – BRIDGE LAKE DRIVE FROM LAKE BEND ROAD TO NORTH TOWN ROAD**

Please be advised that construction on Bridge Lake Drive will soon begin.

**Construction Start: Week of September 9, 2024**  
**Duration: Approximately 4-5 weeks, weather permitting**

Work will include:

- Installing new catch basins
- Constructing new raised concrete crosswalks
- Constructing new asphalt speed tables
- Restoring the boulevard

During construction we will:

- Change Bridge Lake Drive to a one-way southbound
- Remove on-street parking
- Continue to pick up garbage and recycling as scheduled
- Maintain pedestrian access to all properties
  - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time

Please contact me if you have:

- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions or concerns about the project

New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
