Please be advised that construction on Bridge Lake Drive will soon begin.

Construction Start:	Week of September 9, 2024
Duration:	Approximately 4-5 weeks, weather permitting

Work will include:

September 3, 2024

- Installing new catch basins
- Constructing new raised concrete crosswalks
- · Constructing new asphalt speed tables
- Restoring the boulevard

During construction we will:

- Change Bridge Lake Drive to a one-way southbound
- Remove on-street parking
- Continue to pick up garbage and recycling as scheduled
- Maintain pedestrian access to all properties
  - o Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time

- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
