## **1<sup>st</sup> CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF DAHLIA AVENUE**

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -  
DAHLIA AVENUE FROM SINCLAIR STREET TO END**

We are planning road construction on Dahlia Avenue.

**Construction start window: Week of October 14, 2024**  
**Duration: Approximately 3 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Repair the pavement
- Restore the boulevard and approaches as needed

During construction:

- Dahlia Avenue from Sinclair Street to End will be local-access only
  - The street will be closed to through traffic
  - We will maintain access to all intersections
  - Residents with garages or parking facing Dahlia must park elsewhere
  - Emergency access will be maintained
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
  - For properties on Carruthers Avenue, put out your carts as usual
  - For properties on Sinclair Street, put out your carts on the non-parking side of Sinclair Street
  - The contractor will relocate carts as needed
  - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
