2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF DUDLEY AVENUE

**RE: 2024 LOCAL INDUSTRIAL STREET RENEWALS
DUDLEY AVENUE – FROM PEMBINA HIGHWAY TO END**

Road construction on Dudley Avenue from Pembina Highway to end will soon begin.

Construction start window: July 02, 2024
Duration: 8 Weeks

We will:

- Reconstruct the roadway and curb (Pembina Hwy to Daly St N)
- Reconstruct private approaches (Pembina Hwy to Daly St N)
- Repair sections of curb and sidewalk (Daly St N to End)
- Repair sections of pavement (Daly St N to End)
- Place new asphalt
- Restore approaches and boulevards

During construction:

- The road will be closed to traffic from Pembina Hwy to Daly St N
- We will maintain two-way traffic from Daly St N to End
- There will be no on-street parking.
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties

Please contact if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.

Notification will be given before new asphalt is placed. If there is a delay between pavement repairs and new asphalt, on-street parking will be restored.
