CONSTRUCTION NOTICE - UPDATE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF ELLICE AVENUE

RE: 2024 PAVEMENT RENEWALS – ELLICE AVENUE – FROM EMPRESS ST TO ERIN ST

Construction on Ellice Ave has been postponed one week and the traffic plan has been revised (see below).

NEW Construction start date: August 26, 2024
Duration: Approximately 10 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair roadway pavement
- Repair curbs and sidewalk as required
- Place an asphalt pavement overlay
- Restore approaches and boulevards as required

During construction:

- One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction
- There will be no access to alleys from Ellice Ave
- Access to Ellice Ave from side streets will be restricted to right turns only
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain the sidewalk on at least one side of the street at all times

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinklers or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
