RE: 2024 NEW ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PATHWAY, PATHWAY RENEWALS AND TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS – BRANDON AVENUE TO OSBORNE STREET

Please be advised that construction of the new active transportation pathway along Osborne Street and Woodward Avenue back lane will soon begin.

Construction Start Date: Week of September 3, 2024
Duration: Approximately 4-5 weeks, weather permitting

Work will include:

- Installing new catch basin and catch pit
- Constructing new concrete curb and sidewalk
- Constructing new asphalt pathway
- Restoring the boulevard

During construction we will:

- Maintain two-way traffic on Osborne Street
- Maintain pedestrian access to properties
- Change the north side of Woodward Avenue's back lane to a one-way eastbound
- Continue garbage and recycling as scheduled
