TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF TRANQUILITY COVE

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
TRANQUILITY COVE FROM GILMORE AVENUE TO SUMMERFIELD WAY**

We are planning road construction on Tranquility Cove this summer.

Construction start window: Week of September 9, 2024
Duration: Approximately 5 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair the pavement
- Repave the road with an asphalt overlay
- Restore the boulevard and approaches as needed

During construction:

- Tranquility Cove from Gilmore Avenue to Summerfield Way will be local-access only
 - The street will be closed to through traffic
 - We will maintain access to all intersections
 - There will be no on-street parking
 - Emergency access will be maintained
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Put out your carts as usual
 - The contractor will relocate carts as needed
 - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
