TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES NEAR OSBORNE STREET, WOODWARD AVENUE, AND GLASGOW AVENUE

RE: 2024 NEW ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PATHWAY, PATHWAY RENEWALS AND TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS – BRANDON AVENUE TO OSBORNE STREET

Please be advised that a new active transportation pathway project has been approved for construction this summer along Osborne Street, Woodward Avenue, and Glasgow Avenue.

Construction Start: August to October 2024
Duration: Approximately 4-6 weeks, weather permitting

Work will include:

- Installing new catch basin and catch pit
- Constructing new concrete curb and sidewalk
- Constructing new asphalt pathway
- Restoring the boulevard

During construction we will:

- Maintain two-way traffic Osborne Street
- Maintain two-way traffic Glasgow Avenue
- Change Woodward Avenue Northside Backlane to one direction of travel
- Maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time
