PRELIMINARY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF BLENHEIM AVENUE

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
BLENHEIM AVENUE FROM ST. ANNE'S ROAD TO DES MEURONS STREET**

Please be advised Blenheim Avenue will be under construction this summer.

Construction Start: May to September 2024

**Duration: Stage 1 - St. Anne's Rd. to Overton St., Approximately 5-6 weeks, weather permitting
Stage 2 - Overton St. to Des Meurons St., Approximately 6-8 weeks, weather permitting**

Work will include:

- Renewing of existing sidewalks as required
- Excavating the existing roadway
- Repairing sewer infrastructure and installing new catch basins
- Constructing new concrete curb and concrete approaches
- Constructing new asphalt pavement
- Restoring the boulevard

During construction we will:

- Completely close the road to traffic in Stage 1, while maintaining traffic in Stage 2
- Completely close the road to traffic in Stage 2, while maintaining traffic in Stage 1
- Remove on-street parking on the closed Stage; motorists will be required to park their vehicles on a nearby street or back lane as properties allow
- Maintain pedestrian access to all residences and businesses; however, sidewalks will be restricted to one side of the street at a time during a specific phase of construction
