2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF DE VRIES AVENUE

**RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
DE VRIES AVENUE FROM MCIVOR AVENUE TO HEADMASTER ROW**

Please be advised road construction on De Vries Avenue from Mclvor Avenue to Headmaster Row will soon begin.

Construction Start Window: Week of June 23rd, 2025
Duration: Approximately 7-9 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Installing new catch pits
- Excavate and repave the existing roadway
- Constructing new asphalt pathway
- Constructing new curb and sidewalk
- Mill existing asphalt road and construct new asphalt resurfacing
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- De Vries Avenue will maintain one lane open for traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual and Contractor will relocate bins for collection if needed, please mark your address on your bins so they can be returned to the correct address

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions or concerns about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
