2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF AMBERGATE DRIVE

RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM, NEW MULTI-USE PATHWAY, AND NEW SIDEWALK - AMBERGATE DRIVE (FRONTAGE ROADS) FROM AMBER TRAIL TO PIPELINE ROAD

Please be advised that construction on Ambergate Drive (frontage roads) will begin soon.

Construction Start Date: Week of May 22nd, 2025
Duration: Approximately 6-7 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Fix damaged pavement, curbs, and sidewalks
- Construct new asphalt pathway and new concrete sidewalk
- Repave the frontage roads with asphalt
- Restore the boulevards

During construction:

- We will work on one direction of travel at a time
 - We will fully close traffic in the lane we are working
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Westbound and Eastbound Transit stops will be maintained
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual

- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
