CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF BLOSSOM BAY

RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM:

BLOSSOM BAY - McDOWELL DRIVE TO McDOWELL DRIVE

We are planning road construction on Blossom Bay from McDowell Drive to McDowell Drive this spring/summer.

Construction start window: June 2, 2025

Duration: Approximately 7 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove existing pavement and install new asphalt pavement with concrete curb and gutter
- Renew private approaches to property line
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- The street will be reconstructed in two stages
 - o Stage 1 will be the north leg of Blossom Bay from McDowell Drive to 50 Blossom Bay
 - o Parking will be allowed in the Stage 2 area during Stage 1 construction
 - o The Stage 1 area will remain open during Stage 2 construction
 - o Parking will be allowed in the Stage 1 area during Stage 2 construction
- There will be no parking or driveway access in the active construction zone
- Pedestrian access along the boulevards will be maintained
- Place your garbage, recycling and yard waste in the usual spot on collection day

- Accessibility needs, access requirements, or moving / delivery requirements
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Planned special events
