Please be advised that the construction in Carey Park located between Elm Park Road and Kingston Row will begin soon.

**Construction Start Date:** Week of July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025  
**Duration:** Approximately 4-5 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove the existing sidewalk and construct a new asphalt pathway
- Renew the curb ramp and sidewalk
- Install new accessible bench nodes and renew park benches
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Carey Park sidewalk/pathway will be closed
- There will be no on-street parking on Elm Park Road from Killarney Street to the Public Lane
- We will maintain access to all residences

*NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed as a part of this project. While the contractor will maintain turf for approximately a month, we do not maintain residential turf on an ongoing basis.*
