2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF CORINNE STREET

**RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
CORINNE STREET FROM OAKLAND AVENUE TO MARK PEARCE AVENUE**

Please be advised road construction on Corinne Street from Oakland Avenue to Mark Pearce Avenue will soon begin.

Construction Start Window: Week of June 2nd, 2025
Duration: Approximately 5-6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Replace sidewalks
- Fix damaged pavement and curbs
- Repave the roadway with asphalt
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Corinne Street will maintain one lane open for traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual and Contractor will relocate bins for collection if needed, please mark your address on your bins so they can be returned to the correct address

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions or concerns about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
