## **2<sup>nd</sup> CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**TO: RESIDENTS OF HASTINGS BOULEVARD**

**RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM - HASTINGS BOULEVARD FROM  
DUNKIRK DRIVE TO WEST LIMIT**

Please be advised that the construction on Hastings Boulevard from Dunkirk Drive to the west limit of the roadway will begin soon.

**Construction Start Date:** Week of July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025  
**Duration:** Approximately 5-7 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Renew the sidewalk as required
- Excavate the existing roadway
- Repair sewer infrastructure and install new catch basins
- Construct new concrete curb and concrete approaches
- Construct an asphalt approach with concrete curbs
- Construct new asphalt pavement
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Hastings Boulevard will be closed
- Sidewalk access will be maintained once sidewalk repairs are completed
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all residences
- There will be no on street parking
- Garbage pick-up will be located on the north east corner of Hastings Boulevard and Dunkirk Drive
  - The contractor will be responsible for collecting and returning Refuse/Recycling bins to their respective properties

*NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed as a part of this project. While the contractor will maintain turf for approximately a month, we do not maintain residential turf on an ongoing basis.*
