2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF RADFORD STREET

**RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
RADFORD STREET FROM COLLEGE AVENUE TO MOUNTAIN AVENUE**

Please be advised road construction on Radford Street from College Avenue to Mountain Avenue will soon begin.

Construction start window: Week of September 8th, 2025
Duration: Approximately 4-5 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair damaged pavement
- Install new catch pits and a new manhole
- Fix trouble areas on curbs and sidewalks
- Build a new sidewalk on both sides of Radford Street
- Asphalt pave the road
- Restore the boulevards

During construction:

- The lanes we are working on will be closed to traffic
 - We will complete one direction at a time
 - The unaffected direction of traffic will remain open
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions or concerns about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
