2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF WHYTE AVE

**RE: 2025 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM -
WHYTE AVE – FROM BURY ST TO VINE ST**

We are planning road construction on Whyte Ave this summer.

Construction start window: The week of September 8, 2025
Duration: Approximately 8-10 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair the sewer and install new catch basins
- Fix sidewalks
- Build a new curb
- Excavate and reconstruct the existing roadway
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- The street will be closed to traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

NOTE: Your garbage collection schedule will remain the same. However, bins must be moved to Gallagher Avenue for collection.

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
