TO: RESIDENTS OF CORYDON AVENUE-OXFORD STREET
RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM:
CORYDON AVENUE/OXFORD STREET ALLEY – CAMBRIDGE STREET/FLEET AVENUE

We are planning road construction on Corydon Avenue/Oxford Street Alley – Cambridge Street/Fleet Avenue this summer.

Construction start window: Stage 2 commences September 8, 2025

Duration: Approximately 6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove the existing pavement
- Construct new asphalt pavement

During construction:

- The Alley will be reconstructed in two stages
 - Stage 1 will be completed from Fleet Avenue to House No 550 Oxford Street on September 5, 2025
 - Stage 2 will commence from House No 550 Oxford Street to Corydon Avenue on September 8, 2025
 - Access to driveways will be allowed in the Stage 1 area during Stage 2 construction
- There will be no parking or driveway access in the active construction zone
- Parking will be available on the front street
- Garbage and recycling pickup will be completed at the front of properties on Oxford Street and Cambridge Street for the entire alley between Fleet Avenue and Corydon Avenue

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
