CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

**TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF DONALD STREET BETWEEN BROADWAY STREET
AND RIVER AVENUE**

RE: MIDTOWN BRIDGE MAINTENANCE REPAIRS AND RELATED WORKS

We are planning rehabilitation work on the Midtown (Donald Street) Bridge over the Assiniboine River this summer.

Construction start: August 2025
Duration: Approximately 10 weeks

We will:

- Remove and replace parts of the structural steel girders under the bridge
- Paint the new structural steel plates

During construction:

- The speed limit will be reduced
- The southbound curb lane will be closed
- The west sidewalk on the bridge will be closed
- Some on-street parking may be temporarily removed
- The Forks riverwalk trail under the bridge will be closed at times
- The sidewalk under the south side of the bridge will be closed at times
- Boats and canoes may be stopped, on either side of the bridge, for short periods of time
