We are planning construction on Somerville Avenue/Windermere Avenue Alley – Point Road to Riverside Drive this summer/fall.

**Construction start window: September 3, 2025**

**Duration: Approximately 8 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Install a new land drainage sewer
- Remove the existing gravel roadway
- Construct new asphalt pavement

During construction:

- The alley will be closed to all traffic with no parking or driveway access
- Parking will be available on the front street
- Garbage and recycling pickup will be completed at the front boulevard of properties on Somerville, Windermere and Riverside
