CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF SURFSIDE CRESCENT

**RE: 2025 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
SURFSIDE CRESCENT FROM DESJARDINS DRIVE TO DE LA SEIGNEURIE
BOULEVARD**

We are planning road construction on Surfside Crescent this summer.

Construction start window: Week of August 25, 2025
Duration: Approximately 6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair the pavement
- Adjust manholes and drainage inlets
- Repave the road with an asphalt overlay
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- Surfside Crescent from Desjardins Drive to De la Seigneurie will be local-access only
 - The street will be closed to through traffic
 - We will maintain access to all intersections
 - There will be no on-street parking
 - Emergency access will be maintained
 - Driveway access may be restricted if work is occurring in front of your home or on your approach. Notice will be provided by the contractor.
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Put out your carts as usual
 - The contractor will relocate carts as needed
 - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
