TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF BEAVERHILL BOULEVARD

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM -
BEAVERHILL BOULEVARD – FERMOR AVENUE TO SHAMROCK DRIVE**

We are planning road construction on Beaverhill Boulevard this summer.

Construction start window: May to June 2026
Duration: Approximately 12 - 14 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair the concrete roadway
- Replace concrete curbs
- Repair sidewalks
- Repave the road with asphalt
- Regrade the boulevards

During construction:

- Beaverhill Boulevard will be converted to a one-way street and traffic will be reduced to one lane
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
