## 1<sup>st</sup> CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

**TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF EDMONTON ST**

**RE: 2026 DOWNTOWN PAVEMENT RENEWALS – ST. MARY AVE, EDMONTON ST,  
AND KENNEDY ST**

Road construction on Edmonton Street between Broadway and Portage Avenue will soon begin.

**Construction start date: Week of April 20, 2026**  
**Duration: Approximately 26 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Reconstruct the roadway with concrete pavement
- Replace curbs and sidewalk
- Replace underground infrastructure
- Restore approaches and boulevards as required
- Install new protected bi-directional bike lane
- Replace traffic signals and streetlights as required
- Add pedestrian lighting and streetscaping features

During construction:

- Edmonton will be limited to one lane of traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain the sidewalk on both sides of the street at all times
  - During work on the sidewalk, a dedicated pathway on the street with temporary ramps to businesses and residents will be maintained
