1st CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF ST. MARY AVE

**RE: 2026 DOWNTOWN PAVEMENT RENEWALS – ST. MARY AVE, EDMONTON ST,
AND KENNEDY ST**

Road construction on St. Mary Avenue between Edmonton Street and Memorial Boulevard will soon begin.

Construction start date: Week of April 27, 2026
Duration: Approximately 24 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Reconstruct the roadway with concrete pavement
- Replace curbs and sidewalk
- Replace underground infrastructure
- Restore approaches and boulevards as required
- Upgrade existing painted bike lane to a new protected bike lane
- Replace traffic signals and streetlights as required
- Add pedestrian lighting, trees, and streetscaping features

During construction:

- St. Mary will be limited to one lane of traffic
- There will be no on-street parking, except for dedicated parking/loading in front of the Winnipeg Clinic
- We will maintain the sidewalk on both sides of the street at all times
 - During work on the sidewalk, a dedicated pathway on the street with temporary ramps to businesses and residents will be maintained
