We are planning road construction on Sweetwood Bay this summer.

**Construction start window: May – August 2026**  
**Duration: Approximately 7-8 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Repair and replace sewer infrastructure
- Repair damaged pavement, curbs, and sidewalks
- Pave the roadway with asphalt
- Restore boulevards

During construction:

- We will work on one direction of travel at a time
  - We will fully close traffic in the lane we are working
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
  - Sidewalks will be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Garbage and recycling pick-up will continue as scheduled

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
