**TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF McKENZIE STREET**

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM –  
McKENZIE STREET FROM JEFFERSON AVENUE TO KINGSBURY AVENUE**

Please be advised that road construction on McKenzie Street will begin soon.

**Construction start date: Stage 2 - Hartford Ave. to Kingsbury Ave.  
Week of July 6, 2026**

**Duration: Approximately 9-10 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Excavate existing roadway
- Repair sidewalks
- Repair and install sewer infrastructure
- Construct new curbs, approaches, and pave the roadway with asphalt
- Construct new raised crosswalks and sidewalk along Ecole Belmont
- Restore boulevards

During construction:

- McKenzie Ave.- Stage 2 will be fully closed to Traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- There will be no vehicle access to approaches and garages facing McKenzie Ave.
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
  - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
  - Please place your bins as usual and Contractor will relocate bins for collection if needed, please mark your address on your bins so they can be returned to the correct address
- Mail delivery to the community mailboxes on McKenzie Ave. may be paused while the sidewalk is repaired. You can pick up your mail at the Canada Post Depot or wait until access is restored.

  - Hours are Monday to Friday - 9:30am to 1:30pm
