Please be advised that construction on the Adsum Drive/Sasaki Crescent alley will begin soon.

**Construction start date: Week of June 1, 2026**

**Duration: Approximately 2-3 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Repair damaged pavement
- Restore sod

During construction:

- The alley will be fully closed
- There will be no vehicle access to garages and parking pads
- Residents will be required to park their vehicles on a nearby street during construction
- Garbage and recycling pick-up will continue as scheduled;
  - Please place bins out as usual on collection days
  - The Contractor will relocate bins for collection, **please mark your address on your bins** so they can be returned to the correct address
