2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF KING EDWARD STREET AND NOTRE DAME AVENUE

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
RED RIVER COLLEGE PATHWAY FROM DALTON CRESCENT TO SKINNER ROAD**

Please be advised construction of a new pathway along the north side of Notre Dame Ave and west side of King Edward Street will soon begin.

Construction Start: July 20th, 2026
Duration: Approximately 5-6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Replace concrete sidewalk as required
- Construct a new asphalt pathway behind the existing sidewalk
- Relocate and upgrade existing streetlights
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- We will work in the curb lane Southbound King Edward and Westbound Notre Dame
 - We will fully close traffic in the lane we are working during non-peak hours only
- There will be no on-street parking
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all residences and businesses

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod will be placed on the boulevards as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
