1st CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF BANNATYNE AVENUE AND MCDERMOT AVENUE

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
ARLINGTON ALLEY FROM ARLINGTON STREET TO TECUMSEH STREET**

We are planning road construction on Arlington Alley this summer.

Construction Start Window: May to October 2026
Duration: Approximately 5-6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Replace existing sidewalks as required
- Excavate the existing alley
- Repair concrete approaches
- Construct new asphalt pavement
- Restore the boulevards

During construction:

- Arlington Alley will be fully closed to traffic
- Residents will be required to park their vehicles on a nearby street during construction

Temporary Parking Permits:

- A maximum of 2 temporary parking permits per residence will be made available to affected properties
- Temporary parking permits will only be valid on the following streets:
 - McDermot Avenue – Tecumseh Street to McPhillips Street
 - Bannatyne Avenue – Tecumseh Street to McPhillips Street
- Temporary parking permits will authorize vehicles to:
 - Park on designated paid parking streets without payment
 - Park in time-limited areas in excess of posted time restrictions
 - Remain valid for the duration of the construction period only
 - Notices will be delivered providing an expiration date once confirmed
- Residents will be required to submit their name, address, and vehicle license plate number to **ehansen@winnipeg.ca** to obtain a temporary parking permit
