2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF KINGS DRIVE

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM – KINGS DRIVE FROM KILKENNY DR
TO SEIER BAY AND KINGS PARK ROADS AND PATH**

We are planning road construction on Kings Drive this summer and in Kings Park on the roadways and path. Information can be found about the new path in Kings Park on the City of Winnipeg website: <https://legacy.winnipeg.ca/publicworks/parksOpenSpace/ParkAreas/NewProjects/newparks.stm>

Construction start date: The week of June 8th 2026, weather permitting
Duration: Approximately 6-8 weeks

We will:

- Remove the existing asphalt
- Repair the asphalt roadway
- Replace concrete curbs where required
- Repair sidewalks where required
- Repave the road with asphalt
- Regrade the boulevards
- Construct new asphalt path extension along Kings Dr on east side to connect to the University of Manitoba
- Construct new asphalt path within Kings Park Dog Park area.

During construction:

- Kings Drive will be converted to a one-way street with traffic permitted to travel in one direction only depending on the construction Stage
- There will be no on-street parking
- Access to private approaches will be limited at times
- Transit will be re-routed as necessary
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
