1st CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: USERS OF KINGS PARK

RE: 2026 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM – KINGS PARK ROAD AND KINGS PARK PATH

We are planning construction on the roadway entrance to Kings Park and on a new asphalt pathway within the dog park. Information about the new path in Kings Park can be found on the City of Winnipeg website: <https://legacy.winnipeg.ca/publicworks/parksOpenSpace/ParkAreas/NewProjects/newparks.stm>

Construction start window: August to September 2026, weather permitting
Duration: Approximately 4 - 6 weeks

We will:

- Excavate the existing roadway
- Construct a new asphalt pavement structure for the road and pathway
- Repave the road with asphalt
- Repave the parking lot with adjacent washroom facilities
- Adding new benches and waste receptacles
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Vehicular access to the primary Kings Park parking lot will be maintained
- Pedestrian access to the dog park will be maintained
- Access to the washroom facilities will be maintained
- Temporary snow fencing will be installed during construction to separate construction areas from useable park areas

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
