**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**TO: RESIDENTS/BUSINESS OWNERS ON BRADFORD STREET**  
**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM:**  
**BRADFORD STREET – WELLINGTON AVENUE TO SASKATCHEWAN AVENUE**

---

**Construction start: May 19, 2026**  
**Duration: 16 weeks weather permitting**

We will:

- Remove existing pavement and install new concrete pavement, curb and sidewalk
- Renew private approaches to property line
- Renew existing asphalt parking areas along the back of curb
- Restore the boulevard

The project is broken into two stages:

**Stage 1 – West Lane of Bradford Street from Wellington Avenue to Saskatchewan Avenue**

- Scheduled for May 19, 2026 to July 10, 2026
- Traffic closure will be on the Westbound Lane of Bradford Street
- One way traffic will be on Northbound Bradford Street

**Stage 2 – East Lane of Bradford Street from Wellington Avenue to Saskatchewan Avenue**

- Scheduled for July 13, 2026 to mid September
- Traffic closure will be on the Eastbound Lane of Bradford Street
- One way traffic will be on Southbound Bradford Street

A construction notice will be delivered one week prior to the commencement of Stage 2 construction.

Pedestrian and vehicle access to properties will be maintained as much as possible with short-term, temporary adjustments as required and no parking will be allowed on the street. Any disruption to access will be communicated to the affected properties in advance.
