CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES AT PORTAGE AVENUE AND MAIN STREET INTERSECTION

RE: PORTAGE AVENUE AND MAIN STREET PEDESTRIAN OPENING PROJECT

Crews are expected to install additional lane closures the week of December 16, 2024. Sewer repairs and demolition work on the existing pedestrian barricades will continue.

New traffic restrictions expected to be in place starting the week of December 16, 2024 include:

- Main Street
 - One additional lane closure on northbound Main Street from Pioneer Avenue to Lombard Avenue
 - This brings us to two closed northbound lanes here
- Portage Avenue
 - One additional closed lane on eastbound Portage Avenue from Fort Street to Main Street
 - This brings us to two closed eastbound lanes here
 - Closure of one lane on westbound Portage Avenue from Main Street to Notre Dame Ave
 - Partial closure of the westbound Portage Avenue right turn lane to Notre Dame Ave prior to the intersection
- Portage Avenue E
 - One lane closure of westbound Portage Avenue E from Westbrook Street to Main Street

Continued lane closures include:

- Two lane closures of southbound Main Street from Lombard Avenue to Pioneer Avenue
- Continued closure of eastbound curb lane on Portage Avenue E between Main Street and Westbrook Street
