We are planning to resume restoration work on Whyte Ave this summer.

**Construction start window: The week of June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026**  
**Duration: Approximately 1 week, weather permitting**

We will

- Sawcut and seal concrete joints
- Restore the boulevard by placing new topsoil and sod.

During construction the street will be open to traffic.

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

*NOTE: Your garbage collection schedule will remain the same.*

*NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.*
