RE: 2026 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM –JOHNSON AVENUE E – GATEWAY RD TO GREY ST

Road reconstruction of Johnson Avenue E has begun.

Construction start window: Week of June 9, 2026
Duration: Approximately 8-10 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Reconstruct existing alley from Johnson Ave E to #619 Windsor Ave

During construction:

- The alley will be closed to through traffic except for emergency vehicles.
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
- Garbage and recycling days will not change
 - Residents are asked to place their garbage and recycling bins on the front street for the duration of the construction

NOTE: New topsoil and sod will be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
