## **2<sup>nd</sup> CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**TO: AREA RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF ABINOJII MIKANAH**

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM -  
ABINOJII MIKANAH – EASTBOUND BETWEEN RIVER RD TO ST. ANNE’S RD**

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We are completing road construction on eastbound Abinojii Mikanah this summer.

**Construction start window: June 10, 2024**  
**Duration: Approximately 19 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Remove existing curb and asphalt overlay
- Recycle the existing concrete pavement in-place
- Repave the road with an asphalt overlay
- Reconstruct and pave the shoulders with asphalt
- Regrade and restore the boulevard

During construction:

- The lanes we are working on will be closed to traffic
  - One lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained at all times
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
  - Sidewalks may be closed including access to the Mercy Tunnel pedestrian underpass

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions about the project

*NOTE: New topsoil and sod/seed may be placed on the boulevard as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.*
