CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Businesses and Residents

RE: Creek Bend Road Bridge Replacement – Creek Bend Road over the Seine River

We will soon begin work on the Creek Bend Road Bridge project. We will replace the existing bridge, reconstruct Creek Bend Road in the immediate vicinity of the bridge, and build a new sidewalk and multi-use pathway south of the bridge along Creek Bend Road.

Neither your property itself nor access to it will be impacted. The work will, however, change the traffic flow in the area.

Stage 1 Construction: November and December 2023

We will remove shrubs and trees and work on overhead power lines.

We expect minimal traffic impacts. They may include:

• Limited single-lane closures with either yields or flagpersons on-site to direct traffic

Manitoba Hydro will work on overhead power lines shortly before Christmas. Manitoba Hydro will contact any property that may lose power due to their work.

Stage 2 Construction: January - September 2024

This is when we will work on the bridge and road.

Traffic Impacts:

- Creek Bend Road will be fully closed at the bridge beginning in early January 2024
 - We expect to reopen the road in September 2024
- Traffic will be detoured to Sioux Road West and Aimes Road:







We recognize this project will cause some inconvenience and apologize for the disruption.
