

Upcoming Water Main Construction – St. Mary Ave (Vaughan St to Edmonton St)

Starting the week of April 27, 2026, we will begin a 5-week project to replace the water main on your street.

During construction

We will have to shut your water off one or two times while we replace your water main. We try to give you at least 24 hours' notice before we turn off your water. If you are a business, we will do everything we can to schedule this outside of your regular business hours.

If water needs to be off for an extended period of time, we will connect your building to another temporary water service. To set up this service, we will connect your outside tap to another water source and ask you to turn off the valve on your water meter.

In an emergency, water may be shut off without notice. It will be turned back on as soon as possible, usually within four to six hours.

Your water may be cloudy and taste a little different after the work is complete. Your water is still safe to use in this condition, and will return to normal within a few days.

There may be parking and traffic restrictions, but you will always have access to your home. Please keep away from the construction site at all times.

There will be no impacts to your:

- Sewer service
- Recycling and garbage collection

We will restore any boulevard and pavement damage as soon as possible.
