The work will pose **logistical challenges** for fronting property owners and other stakeholders in the construction area.




**Communicating with the stakeholders will be crucial** for maintaining access and reducing their logistical issues during construction.




The work will result in new infrastructure which will **improve safety** for drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians.

Inventory of existing road conditions in the study area




## SAFE INTERSECTIONS





» The first round of meetings will focus on introducing the project and preliminary design ideas. We will connect with stakeholders and the public to share project updates and gather feedback.


# CROSS SECTIONS

- » The next boards take you through each one, **highlighting the possible changes** in the area.




# CROSS SECTION - Carlton Street (facing north)

Portage Ave. to Graham Ave.






