CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

**RE: 2021-2022 Regional Street Renewal Program – Wall Street Reconstruction,
St. Matthews Avenue to Wellington Avenue – CONSTRUCTION START**

Please be advised road construction on Wall Street from St. Matthews Avenue to Wellington Avenue is scheduled to begin the week of April 19th. As a part of this 2 year project, Wall Street will be reconstructed from Wellington Avenue to Notre Dame Avenue in 2022.

Construction start: Week of April 19, 2021

Duration: 6 months

Impacted streets and intersections: Wall Street - St. Matthews Avenue to Wellington Avenue

Work on Wall Street will include:

- Full excavation of the existing roadway
- Construction of a new asphalt pavement structure
- Full excavation and construction of concrete approaches
- Sidewalk reconstruction
- Boulevard regrading

Traffic Implications:

- Traffic on Wall Street will be limited to one lane throughout construction.
- Phase 1 will move traffic into the east gutter lane; Phase 2 will move traffic into the west gutter lane. Phase 3 will involve shifting traffic intermittently to accommodate final paving.
- On-street parking will be prohibited throughout the entire construction period.
- Turning movements, left and right, may be restricted at St. Matthews Avenue, Ellice Avenue, and Sargent Avenue.
- Access to business/residences will be maintained along with pedestrian access.

We recognize this project will cause some inconvenience and apologize for the disruption.
